## The United States Department of Energy Announces the Availability of the Administrative Record File

### Rocky Flats Plant Golden, Colorado

#### ADMIN RECORD

The Administrative Record file under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) is a collection of all documents which are relied upon to select a responsible party for the clean up of individual hazardous substance sites (HSS). Requirements for Administrative Records are established under section 113 (g) of CERCLA, as amended by Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA) of 1986. The Department of Energy (DOE) seeks to inform the public of the record file and to encourage the public to comment on documents as they are placed in the record file.

The Administrative Record file includes documents which form the basis for the selection of remedial actions at the Rocky Flats Plant. Records available to date for Operable Units 1 through 11 (OU 1-11) and the sitewide file are available for the public to review.
