The RFP Historical Release Report (HRR) was released after several of the Final Phase I RFI/RI Workplans were submitted to the regulators and the Natural Resource Trustees. The experience at OU 8 indicated that changes in IHSS locations were necessary, based on the new information contained in the HRR. Thus, the Phase I RFI/RI Workplan for OU 8 incorporates results from the HRR in the Field Sampling Plan.

We request that EG&G review the HRR and existing RFI/RI Workplans for OUs 8, 9, 10, 12, 13 and 14 in order to verify that the Field Sampling Plans are based on the most recent information. If it is determined that modifications of existing Field Sampling Plans are necessary, EG&G should submit technical memoranda to the existing workplans detailing the changes (e.g, adding PACs, IHSS sampling location, analyte classes, etc.). The technical memoranda should be submitted to DOE/RFO for review prior to review by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Colorado Department of Health (CDH) and the other Trustees. In addition, sampling activities at the affected IHSSs and PACs should be delayed until formal approval has been granted by EPA and CDH.

A memorandum should be transmitted to DOE/RFO by August 13, 1993, identifying those OUs, IHSSs and PACs requiring the preparation of technical memoranda. If no modifications are necessary, the memorandum to DOE/RFO should state this. However, if modifications are necessary, your response should include the proposed submittal date for the draft and final technical memoranda. Finally, there will be both cost and schedule impacts resulting from this activity, especially regarding the PACs. The impacts of the scope increase resulting from the HRR should be indicated for both the schedule and cost at the various OUs.
