Waste Removal from IHSSs 170, 174, 176 and 210

This memorandum is a follow up to DOE/RFO memorandum ERD:BKT:7217, dated July 13, 1992, and EG&G memorandum 92-RF-8715, dated July 31, 1992. The DOE/RFO memorandum requested that all wastes be removed from the following IHSS's:

- 1) IHSSs 170 and 174 (PU&D Storage Area),
- 2) IHSS 176 (S&W Contractor Storage Yard), and
- 3) IHSS 210 (Building 980 Cargo Container).

These IHSSs are scheduled to undergo characterization per the RFP Interagency Agreement between DOE, EPA and CDH. Note that the Draft Phase I RFI/RI Report for OU 10, which includes the above IHSSs, is due to EPA and CDH on August 25, 1994. However, characterization efforts will not be possible at these IHSSs until the waste material has been removed. Thus, efforts must be initiated immediately to remove the waste material. As stated in our July 13, 1992 memorandum, the removal, transport and storage of waste material must achieve compliance with all applicable statutes, regulations and DOE Orders.

We request that, effective immediately, waste and materials no longer be transported to IHSSs 170, 174, 176 and 210 for storage. The continued use of these areas for waste and material storage will only prolong the time required to clean them up for characterization.

In the interim, all waste material currently stored at these IHSS's must be done in such a manner to comply with all applicable statutes, regulations and DOE Orders. In this regard, we refer to the following DOE/RFO memoranda: WMED:FWG:11721, WMED:JPS:11799, WMED:FWG:7095 and WMED:FWG:3682. These memoranda specifically address the PU&D Yard.

The July 31, 1992 EG&G response, stated that a specific date was not available for the removal of wastes from the IHSSs. Instead, it was stated that a cost estimate and storage location need to be determined. It was further stated that this planning will be conducted in concert with the FY93 budget submittal.

We request that EG&G provide a scope, schedule and cost estimate and identify the work package which will fund the efforts for the removal of wastes from the IHSSs to DOE/RFO by December 1, 1992. This should include all relevant assumptions. In addition, this submittal shall include options for storage sites. However, we encourage EG&G to devise permanent solutions to this issue to the extent that is possible.
