

Dear Mr. Hestmark:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our intentions relative to Operable Unit No. 15 (OU-15).

On February 25, 1994, a copy of the Draft OU-15 Technical Memorandum Number 1 (TM-1) was sent to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for review and comment. We requested that EPA provide comments to the Department of Energy (DOE) by March 11, 1994. A meeting was held on March 17, 1994, between DOE, EG&G, EPA and Colorado Department of Health (CDH) to discuss all Draft TM-1 comments, Dave Maxwell represented the EPA. At this meeting, Mr. Maxwell took part in the discussions concerning Draft TM-1 and stated that the EPA's formal comments would be forthcoming shortly.

As of this date we have not received the EPA's formal written comments relative to Draft TM-1. However, based upon Mr. Maxwell's verbal comments at the meeting and the verbal and formal comments received from the CDH, et al., we are undertaking the following actions:

(1) additional equipment blanks have been obtained, and (2) verification sampling will be accomplished in order to assure that any contaminants of concern (COCs) are no longer present in the applicable Individual Hazardous Substance Sites (IHSS). This information will be incorporated into the Final TM-1, which will be sent to the EPA for review and comment on or about May 9, 1994. We are proceeding in order to maintain the schedule necessary to meet the August 1, 1994, submittal of the Draft RFI/RI Report.
