The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed Final Technical Memorandum No. 1 for OU 15 and finds it acceptable with the exceptions expressed in comments from the Colorado Department of Health (CDH). This finding is made with the understanding that DOE intends to continue using the buildings encompassing OU 15 as radiological work areas.

Further discussion between DOE, EPA and CDH is needed to define the controls or remedial standards necessary to protect workers in the buildings and how to administratively manage the process.
