This correspondence is to transmit the enclosed *Draft Original Landfill Geotechnical Investigation Report* (June 2008) for your review and approval. The report was prepared in accordance with the Rocky Flats Original Landfill (OLF) Geotechnical Investigation Work Plan.

The results of the geotechnical investigation provide the basis for considering actions to address the observed slumps and seeps at the OLF, so that the closure objectives for the OLF continue to be achieved. The results of the geotechnical investigation will also help to inform the evaluation of alternative approaches to address problems with maintaining required berm heights and channel slopes as currently defined in the OLF Monitoring & Maintenance (M&M) Plan.

We look forward to consulting with you in the near future to reach agreement on repair actions, so that necessary engineering design work and construction procurement may be completed. This consultation will also facilitate the development of a proposed modification to the OLF M&M Plan to align the requirements with the Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement and to incorporate any changes to inspection and maintenance requirements that may result from the agreed-upon actions.
