The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) has reviewed RFLMA Contact Record 2008-05, which documents consultation regarding instances of concentrations of certain analytes that are greater in RCRA wells downgradient of the OLF than in the upgradient RCRA well. The supplemental analyses and comparisons provided are sufficient to satisfy the consultation requirements of Figure 10 in RFLMA Attachment 2. Monitoring the OLF RCRA wells will therefore continue and additional consultation regarding these specific circumstances will be required only if future trending analyses indicate increasing trends.
