Dear Mr. Surovchak:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment has reviewed RFLMA Contact Record 2011-01, which details actions to reduce effluent concentrations of residual volatile organic compounds (VOCs) from the Mound Site Treatment System. It also covers routine maintenance to replace the ZVI media at this treatment system. Because these actions are within the scope of the remedy prescribed in the CAD/ROD and they meet regulatory requirements, this contact record is approved. Region 8 of the Environmental Protection Agency has also reviewed this contact record and concurs with its approval.

If this action is unsuccessful or additional actions are needed to further reduce VOC concentrations in groundwater, then further consultation is required.
