The Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) Parties, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will host two public informational meetings to discuss the Proposed Plan for amending the Rocky Flats Corrective Action Decision/Record of Decision (CAD/ROD) to clarify several institutional controls governing soil excavation on site.

The purpose of these meetings is to answer several technical questions that were presented during the public meeting held on June 16, 2011 and to provide additional information on risk assessment and worker protection in relationship to excavation at Rocky Flats.

The first technical meeting will be held on Thursday, July 14, 2011 beginning at 2:45 p.m. at the DOE Legacy Management Westminster office, 11025 Dover St., Suite 1000, Westminster, CO. For those who are unable to attend a meeting during normal working hours, a second technical meeting will be held at the Westminster office beginning at 6 p.m., Wednesday, July 20.
