RE: RFLMA Contact Record 2013-03 approval

Dear Mr. Surovchak:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (Department), in coordination with Region 8 of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), has reviewed Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement (RFLMA) Contact Record 2013-03. This contact record describes an evaluation plan and schedule for addressing the reportable condition that currently exists on the Original Landfill cover. A description of the proposed actions is provided in an attached Soil Disturbance Review Plan.

This contact record is consistent with consultation with the Department, which occurred on November 19, 2013. The Department concurs that the actions proposed to stabilize the Original Landfill cover will not result in an unacceptable release or exposure to residual subsurface contamination, and will not damage any component of the remedy. The proposed actions meet the objectives and rationales of Institutional Controls 3 and 6. The Department therefore approves Contact Record 2013-03 along with the accompanying Soil Disturbance Review Plan.

The described work can begin once the final grading design is approved by the Department, but not until 10 calendar days after stakeholders have been notified that the contact record has been posted to the Rocky Flats website.
