The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), in coordination with Region 8 of the Environmental Protection Agency, has reviewed draft Contact Record 2015-02. This contact record provides a Soil Disturbance Review Plan for construction of an upgrade to the photovoltaic power system at the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) storage shed.

Our review has determined that the proposed soil disturbance required by the construction activity will not compromise the function of the remedy and will not result in an unacceptable release or exposure to residual subsurface contamination. The proposed project meets the rationale and objectives of Institutional Control #2 and Contact Record 2015-01 is therefore approved.
