RE: Contact Record 2016-03: Geoprobe investigation upgradient of the Original Landfill

Dear Mr. Surovchak,

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment has reviewed draft Contact Record 2016-03. Because this construction will require excavation subject to Institutional Control #2, this contact record also provides a Soil Disturbance Review Plan.

Our review has determined that the proposed soil disturbance required by the Geoprobe investigation supports the function of the remedy for the Original Landfill and will not result in an unacceptable release or exposure to residual subsurface contamination. The proposed actions are consistent with consultation among the Rocky Flats Legacy Management Agreement parties. The proposed project also meets the rationale and objectives of Institutional Control #2 and Contact Record 2016-03 is therefore approved. As noted, soil disturbance authorized by this contact record will not begin until 10 days after stakeholders are notified that this contact record has been posted on the Rocky Flats Site's website.
