The Colorado Department of Health, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division (the Division) has reviewed the two Standard Operating Procedures referenced above. Both of these procedures are approved pending resolution of the following comments.

On page 5 of GT.31, the second sentence of Section 6.1.1 begins, "Steps 6.1.2 to 6.1.6..." This should probably read, "Steps 6.1.2 to 6.1.4..."

On page 10 of GT.22, additional wording should be added to the first sentence of Section 6.2.7.9 to make it complete. The following wording is suggested: "Use the first sample to purge the downhole probe and then discard it, since it is not a representative sample."
