

**Rocky Flats Citizens Advisory Board
D&D/Closure Plan Focus Group
Meeting Minutes
MAY 18, 1998**

Co-Chair Victor Holm called the meeting to order at 6 00 p m

COMMITTEE BUSINESS:

1) Reuse Recommendation Discussions

Once again the reuse recommendation was discussed within the Focus Group With the guidance of the May 7 Board meeting, the Focus Group members reviewed a new draft of the reuse recommendation and began discussions After lengthy discussions about developing a CAB vision of the site end state, the group chose to delete any mention of a specific reuse and to state that the CAB recommends that no development takes place at the site and that the ultimate reuse decision should be made with greater public involvement The reuse designation, cleanup levels, stewardship, presence/absence of caps, etc will be discussed in the CAB end state vision to be developed in the future

Action: The recommendation will be presented to the Board at the June meeting. Past CAB recommendations will be reviewed to determine their place in an end state vision Time will be slotted in the June 4 Board meeting to propose the development of the vision

2) Natural Resources Management Policy Comment Review

The May 7 Board meeting led to the development of draft comments The draft included comments on the use of prescribed burns, methods of weed control, and concerns over the sustainability of site ecology after DOE leaves the site The comments were reviewed by the Group Changes made to the draft included word-smithing and the addition of a recommendation that DOE initiate a working group with public input to discuss the changes required to Preble's Meadow Jumping Mouse management due to the mouse's recent listing as threatened

Action: The draft will be revised and presented to the Board for approval at the June 4 meeting

3) Decommissioning Program Plan Discussions

The Focus Group, after reviewing the DPP, has chosen not to comment on the document The group was unable to find any major concerns that needed to be expressed to DOE concerning this document

Action: Tom Gallegos will inform the Board at the June 4 meeting that no major problems exist in the DPP

4) Building 886 IM/IRA Discussions

As in the DPP, no major problems were identified by the Focus Group. The IM/IRA will not be commented on unless concerns are expressed by the Board.

Action: The Board will be informed that no comments on the IM/IRA will be forthcoming from the Focus Group at the June 4 meeting.
