

SUBJECT: RETENTION OF OPEN CONTRACT WITH COLORADO BIRD OBSERVATORY,
NO. 343772NM2 - MBM - 092- 95

Confirming our recent conversation, I attended a meeting on September 26, 1995 with DOE, the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Colorado Bird Observatory, and the City of Westminster. After this meeting, John Rampe, DOE, RFFO instructed me that the Kaiser-Hill/RMRS contract with the Colorado Bird Observatory must remain open even though it is not currently funded. Larry Woods, K-H, concurred with this instruction. This contract deals directly with compliance with U. S. Fish and Wildlife directions in accordance with the Endangered Species Act. Cancellation of this contract could result in substantial fines and penalties under the Endangered Species Act if the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service's conditions for approval of construction of the Woman Creek Reservoir are not met. We may be called upon by DOE to activate this contract, on very short notice, at any time in the next two months. Mr. Rampe assured me that funds would be made available if required. This contract must remain open until further notice.
