Dear Gentlemen:

Under the Rocky Flats Cleanup Agreement (RFCA), paragraph 5, the RFCA Parties committed to review annually "all applicable new and revised statutes and regulations and written policy and guidance to determine if an amendment pursuant to Part 19 (Amendment of Agreement) is necessary." Enclosed is a draft for your review and concurrence. Based on the review, no amendment to RFCA is required at this time. However, changes to environmental regulations will be incorporated as modifications into RFCA Appendix 3, Implementation Guidance Document (IGD), Master List of Potential Applicable or Relevant and Appropriate Requirements, IGD Appendix K.

In addition to the annual review prescribed in RFCA paragraph 5, the RFCA Parties committed to conducting an annual review of radionuclide soil action levels (RSALs). Due to the ongoing RSAL review process, which is anticipated to capture the final resolution on RSALs in the 2001 review, the RSAL review section is very brief. Consequently, no changes have been made to the RSALs.
