

RE: Clarification on Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study Work Plan Technical Memorandum and Summary Reports

The Final Work Plan for the Development of the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study Report (DOE 2002) establishes 15 technical requirements or tasks (Tasks). Tasks are designated as "Technical Memorandum" (TM) or "Summary Reports" (SR). Draft TMs and SRs are submitted to EPA and CDPHE for review. TMs describe the expected final cleanup goals. For TMs, a response to comments and a revised TM are prepared and submitted to EPA and CDPHE for review and approval. SRs constitute the remaining sections of the draft RI/FS report. For SRs, a response to comments is prepared and submitted to EPA and CDPHE for review. Comments are incorporated into the SR, but the SR is not resubmitted for EPA and CDPHE review and approval. Task 15 is the preparation of the draft Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study Report. This task is the compilation of the TMs and SRs. EPA and CDPHE will review and approve the draft Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study Report.
