I just received a letter dated 14 December 1998 from M. Iggy Litaor regarding his study of the hydrogeochemistry of Pu in soils of RFP. He explained that because the software and data provided by the site reached him only in mid-August and he was leaving the country till his teaching resumed in November that he had been unable to check out the software and data sent to him until quite recently. He says he then found "many problems and omissions," of which he cites the following as examples:

- "1. I have asked for the depth to the water table in well 1587 from 1995 to present. No data was provided. They did provide georeferenced data, which I already have. 3 *obsest wells*
- "2. I have asked for dxf files of the 903 area combined with the instrumented site. They provided the 903 Pad area but it was cut too short in the east direction so I can not include well number 2687.
- "3. Visual MODFLOW cannot read the dxf files that are in Engineering scale of feet and inches. The dxf files need to be transformed into decimal units using AUTOCAD software. The transformed file needs to be adjusted using the SCALE command and saved using the DXFOUT command. I do not have an access to AUTOCAD nor am I versed with the program.
- "4. Similarly I need the elevation of the site but not in dxf file format but in ASCII format and the coordinates must be modified according to the procedure outlined above."

He assumes that as his work progresses he will encounter other problems. He thinks all such problems could easily be resolved if he was able to communicate directly with a designated on-site person via the Internet -- someone with whom he could get a quick response when a problem arises. He suggested that perhaps the person in charge of GIS (Geographical Information System) would be the appropriate contact.

Accordingly, I am writing to ask if you or Christine Dayton can name someone to play this role of assisting Litaor in finishing his work.
